# Clearwater For Youth (CFY) 2020 College Scholarships...



In 2020, Clearwater for Youth (CFY) will be awarding both \$5,000 and \$10,000 college scholarships to be presented at their Celebrity Banquet on Saturday, February 29, 2020. Each \$5,000 scholarship is currently given over a two year period (\$2,500 per year) and \$10,000 scholarship over a 4 year period (\$2,500 per year) for college expenses.

This award is given to a graduating high school senior that has participated in youth and or high school sports activities as well as other extracurricular activities and has through their participation shown "the highest qualities of good sportsmanship, teamwork and moral standards".

The recipient is recommended by the Clearwater for Youth Scholarship Committee and approved by the Board of Trustees. The recipient should have participated in youth and or high school sports, as well as other activities for a reasonable length of time and demonstrated to their peers and coaches the qualities outlined above.

The award will help defray the costs of tuition, books, room and board or other needed college expenses. Great weight is given in a variety of areas including financial need, academics, sports achievements, leadership and Clearwater for Youth co-sponsor group participation. The target area includes Pinellas County, more specifically in the greater Clearwater, North Pinellas area. To be considered, scholarship candidates should email the CFY application found at <a href="https://www.clearwaterforyouth.org">www.clearwaterforyouth.org</a> along with a one page essay "Why are you Interested in the CFY scholarship" to <a href="mailto:info@clearwaterforyouth.org">info@clearwaterforyouth.org</a>.

The application includes current high school, GPA, extracurricular activities and awards and participation in youth athletics, along with anticipated universities they may plan on attending and sport (s) they may be continuing at the collegiate level. All applications will be reviewed and the scholarship recipient and parents will be invited to attend the CFY Celebrity Banquet, Saturday, February 29, 2020 at the Sheraton Sand Key Resort, Clearwater Beach, where the awards will be presented as part of the program. Recipients will also be invited and recognized by the Mayor and City Council at a Clearwater City Council Meeting this spring.

Deadline for application consideration is <u>January 23, 2020.</u> Recipients will be notified the week of <u>February 4th, 2020</u>.
